

# Home Upgrade Grant

Is your home heating electric, oil, LPG or solid fuel?

You could be eligible for fully-funded home energy efficiency improvements

The Home Upgrade Grant (HUG) funds energy efficiency upgrades for homes that are not connected to the gas network.

Eligible households can apply for home improvements including free insulation, low carbon heating and clean heating systems.



The scheme is managed by **e-on** and local installers will help customers through the application process.

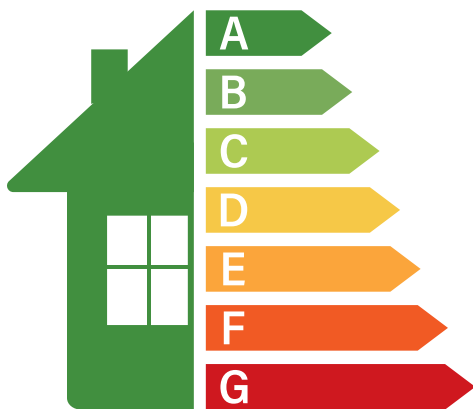
The installer will identify which improvements are best for eligible homes and arrange any necessary surveys and installations.

## Eligibility:-

- The home isn't heated by mains gas (for example, if it's heated by oil, coal, LPG or electric-only heating).
- Has a combined income is less than £36,000 (or an equivalised income where cost of living is below £20,000 after rent or mortgage costs) or receives means-tested benefits such as Universal Credit or is in a target area as identified by the government.
- The home is hard to heat, based on a home Energy Performance Certificate (EPC).
