After campaigning, petitions and presentations, Kent County Council have accepted the case for a 20mph on Sandgate High Street. Tim said:

"I'm delighted for Sandgate. **Residents have campaigned together and fought for this for years.** There is loads still to do, but we've already started.

"The scheme will have to go through consultation and be locally funded (Kent County Council won't pay) so we need to get it fully designed, costed and find the money.

"It's not everything we have called for. There needs to be a lower limit on the Esplanade too in my view, and better enforcement throughout. **But this is a start.**

"Sandgate Speedwatch volunteers are also already doing sessions each week reminding drivers of the current limits: they are there for a reason. Thank you those volunteers working to make our roads safer."
